

Increase in smoking prevalence 2013-2017



	2013	2017
16-24 år	14,0 %	15,6 %
25-34 år	14,4 %	16,2 %
35-44 år	16,3 %	16,8 %
45-54 år	21,0 %	20,0 %
55-64 år	21,4 %	21,1 %
65-74 år	16,9 %	15,2 %
75+ år	12,0 %	10,2 %
Total	17,0 %	17,0 %



The plan for a Smoke-Free Future

We need to build a strong **partnership** with other organisations to fight smoking

Endgame goals inspired by Finland, Sweden and Ireland:

- No children or underage smokers in 2030
- Max. 5 % adult smokers in 2030

Strategy

- Focus on children and tone-of-voice
- Build public support
- Create partnerships and a smoke-free norm
- Call for politicians to change laws

Political breakthrough: Danish Action Plan on Tobacco Control 2019


- Price increases on tobacco
- Plain packs for most tobacco products and e-cigarettes
- **Point of sales ban** for all tobacco products incl. e-cigarettes and nicotine pouches
- Smoke free school time in primary school, secondary/high schools and vocational schools
- Ban on indirect and direct promotion of tobacco, e-cigarettes and nicotine products
- Ban on characterizing flavors with exceptions







Implementation of the Tobacco Control Act - status



Smokefree School-hours

Tobacco- and nicotine-free school hours - admission of children and young people under the age of 18.

Prohibition on the sale of tobacco, e-cigarettes and other nicotine products at the same educational establishments

Neither students, teachers nor others are allowed smoke on the premises

No national rules for staff



Plain Packaging and Display Ban

Requirements for standardized packages for all tobacco products and e-cigarettes, etc.,

- ex. cigars, pipe tobacco and pipes.

Standardization helps to remove the advertising effect of the packages

All tobacco products, e-cigarettes and nicotine products must be hidden away in the shops between sales until a customer specifically demands them. This also applies to the Internet

Prohibition of direct and indirect advertising and sponsorship of tobacco products, e-cigarettes and nicotine products.



Industry Strategies

- Legal case against the Ministry of Health
- Promotion of so called "reduced risk products"
- Undermining tax increases
 - The average price should be 7,39 EUR in 2021, e.g. Marlboro Red was still EUR 6.72
- > Undermine the legislation
 - > Bypass menthol ban
 - > Authority reaction










Smoking in Denmark 2010-2021 (%)



What is next in Denmark?

- ➤ Minister of Health: Nicotine-Free generation 2010+
 - Ban sales of tobacco and nicotine products to people born in 2010 or later
 - Part of Government political proposal for a National Health Plan
- Proposal from other parties:
 - Higher prices
 - Better control of age limits, general focus on enforcement
 - Ban all new products
- > Common goal: Smoke-Free Generation in 2030
