Priority Messages

- Cigarette filters are single-use plastics.
- Cigarette filters are not biodegradable.
- Cigarette butts are the most-littered item in the world.
- Cigarette butts contain toxic chemicals that leach into the ground and water.
- Cigarette filters are a deceptive design feature that give people who smoke the false impression of safety when in fact plastic fibers fall out during the act of smoking and are linked to a more aggressive form of lung cancer.

Priority Positions

- Cigarette filters should be banned to protect our environment and global health.
- The tobacco industry should be excluded from the UN Plastic Pollution Treaty negotiations, in line with the existing global tobacco treaty obligations (Article 5.3 of the WHO FCTC) and United Nations principles and policies (HLM NCDs, UN Global Compact, WHO FENSA).

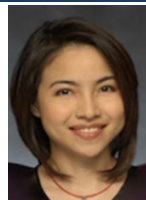

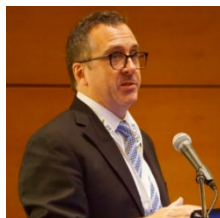
